'B'desh link to Bengal...

The Union home ministry has deployed nearly nine BSF companies, comprising at least 900 personnel, in Murshidabad, where three people were killed.

The development comes after the Centre sought clarification from the state government regarding its failure to protect lives and property, the attack on railway assets, and police inaction during the initial stages of the violence.

Youth shot dead at...

Following the incident, police reached the spot and brought the situation under control. Extra police forces were called from Morena, and heavy security has been placed in the village.

On Tuesday, family members of a deceased staged a protest outside post mortem room demanding justice and accountability. Following the demonstration, the administration agreed to their demands, allowing videography. The body was subsequently sent for cremation.

Stalin forms panel to...

The committee has been tasked with a wide mandate: reviewing constitutional provisions, laws, and policies governing Centre-State dynamics; recommending ways to restore subjects shifted from the State List to the Concurrent List; suggesting reforms for administrative autonomy; and considering earlier recommendations from commissions like the Rajamannar, Sarkaria, and Punchhi Commissions.

Addressing the Assembly, Stalin noted that "India, as envisioned by Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, was never meant to be a unitary State but a Union of States." He lamented the steady erosion of States' powers over the decades, stressing that Tamil Nadu has long championed greater State autonomy.

China suspends...

China's top three airlines - Air China, China Eastern Airlines and China Southern Airlines had planned to take delivery of 45, 53 and 81 Boeing planes, respectively, between 2025 and 2027.

Beijing has also asked that Chinese carriers halt purchases of aircraft-related equipment and parts from U.S. companies, the Bloomberg report said.

REAL PICTURE | Report says current trend is much below the recommendation made by the 1987 Law Commission

'India has only 15 judges per million population'

There are only 15 judges per million population in the country, a far cry from the Law Commission's recommendation of 50 judges per million population, a 2025 report on India's judicial system released on Tuesday said.

In contrast, the USA has 150 judges per million population, according to a January 2024 New York Times news report, and Europe had an average of 220 judges per million in 2022, according to an October 2024 Council of Europe report.

"For 1.4 billion people, India has 21,285 judges, or approximately 15 judges per



million population. This continues to be significantly below the 1987 law commission's recommendation of 50 judges per million population," said the 2025 India Justice Report, which ranks states on the delivery of justice in the country.

While the vacancies in high courts stood at 33 per cent of the total sanctioned

strength, the report claimed 21 per cent vacancies in 2025, indicating a high workload for the existing judges.

"Nationally, in the district courts, the average workload is 2,200 cases per judge. In the Allahabad and Madhya Pradesh High Courts, the caseload per judge amounts to 15,000," the report said.

The overall share of women judges, the report said, in the district judiciary increased from 30 per cent in 2017 to 38.3 per cent, and it increased from 11.4 per cent to 14 per cent in the high courts in 2025.

"There is a higher share of women judges in the district courts as compared to the high courts and the Supreme Court (6 per cent).

Currently, there is only one woman chief justice across the 25 high courts," the report said.

The report said Delhi district courts were among judicial branches with the lowest vacancies in the country with 11 per cent, and in which women comprised 45 per cent judges.

"In the district judiciary, only five per cent of judges belong to scheduled tribes (STs) and 14 per cent are from scheduled castes (SCs). Of the 698 high court judges appointed since 2018, only 37 judges are from SC and ST categories," it added.

The overall representation of other backward castes (OBCs) in the judiciary was 25.6 per cent, the report said.

There is land under Waqf but...: Mithun on Bengal violence

Online Report NEW DELHI

Actor-politician Mithun Chakraborty, in the backdrop of massive violence in Bengal over Waqf, today said this violence is being engineered by those who have so far been illegally enjoying the benefits from Waqf property.

"There is land under Waqf but that is being misused. All this will now come out. Many have rented out Waqf land and are eating on its proceeds. OK you eat, but do share it with your impoverished brothers," he said in an exclusive interview.

Now that the law has been amended, they are worried, he said. "What to do? So they are resorting to violence. Those who are actually taking part in the violence have no clue to what is happening," he said.

Referring to the targets of violence that has been on for the



better part of last week in Bengal's Murshidabad and South 24 Parganas districts, he said, "If you are unhappy with Waqf, why take it out on these people? They are poor people. What do they have to do with Waqf?"

Three people have died in the violence and arson in Murshidabad and many have lost their homes. More than 200 people have been arrested in but the locals are still shaken.

Yesterday, violence rocked South 24 Parganas as supporters of the Indian Secular Front clashed with the police in Bhargar area.

Yogi lambasts Mamata-led govt over Murshidabad violence

Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday launched a sharp attack on the West Bengal government over violence in Murshidabad, accusing the Mamata Banerjee-led government of remaining silent while the situation worsens.

Addressing a gathering here today, CM Yogi also thanked the Calcutta High Court for ordering the deployment of central forces "immediately" in Murshidabad.

"Bengal is burning. The Chief Minister of the state is silent. She calls rioters 'messengers of peace'. But those who understand only force won't listen to words. In the name of secularism, they have given complete freedom to rioters to create unrest. The entire Murshidabad has been on fire for the last week, yet

the government remains silent. Such anarchy must be brought under control," CM Yogi said.

"I thank the judiciary there for deploying central forces to ensure the safety of the minority Hindus in the area. The Congress is silent on the riots in Murshidabad. The Samajwadi Party is also quiet," he said. Yogi Adityanath also praised Prime Minister Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah for passing the Waqf Amendment Act.

"We are grateful to PM Modi and Amit Shah, who, by passing the Waqf Amendment Act, have put an end to the looting of poor people's land. Now, the recovered land will be used to build hospitals, houses for the poor, schools, and universities. The looting of land has come to an end, and that's why these people are upset. They are trying to mislead the public," the Uttar Pradesh CM said.

B'deshi infiltrators' role in Bengal, says probe: Sources

Online Report KOLKATA

An initial investigation into the violence in West Bengal's Murshidabad during anti-Waqf protests suggest the involvement of suspected Bangladeshi elements. Sources said this is the report that the Union Home Ministry has received from the Central forces deployed in the state. The report suggests that these infil-

trators received support from local elements, and the situation escalated when the infiltrators went out of control.

In response to a request from the West Bengal government, the Ministry of Home Affairs has deployed Central Police Forces to help bring the situation under control.

Taking cognisance of the violence, the NHRC on Tuesday said it will send a team from its investigation division to

conduct an on-spot inquiry, given the "seriousness" of the matter.

The National Human Rights Commission said the action comes after submission of a complaint to it. The inquiry report should be submitted within a period of three weeks, it said.
